YOUTH CITY HANDICAP TOURNAMENT RULES 2019-2020 PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT

- **1. Eligibility:** The tournament is open to all current PPUSBC members who have not reached their 18th birthday as of August 1, 2019 and who bowl in certified youth leagues.
- **2. Team Captain:** The team captain or representative is responsible for the submission of each entry and all fees. The team captain is the team representative and will serve in all matters pertaining to individual behavior, and compliance with tournament and USBC rules.
- **3. Participation:** Bowlers may enter multiple team events. No more than two bowlers may participate together on multiple teams. Multiple entries are allowed in doubles with a different partner. Bowlers entering doubles or singles must enter both events. First score in each event will count towards All Events. Individual bowlers may place only once in singles.
- **4. Entry Fees:** Entry fees per bowler, per event breaks down as: prize fund \$7.00, linage \$6.00, and expense fee \$2.00, for a total of \$15.00.
- **5. No Refunds:** No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund once the tournament begins. Prior to the start of the tournament, a refund may be given if the team or individual notifies the association manager that they will be unable to bowl.
- **6. Prize Ratio:** 1 in 5 per division. Each youth winner will receive an award. In the event of a tie, duplicate awards will be given.
- **7. Averages:** The highest 2018-2019 average of 12 games or more will be used or the current average (of 9 games or more) as of January 18, 2020, whichever is higher. Youth without either of these averages will be assigned an average based on his or her division.

Age as of August 1, 2019 determines the division:

All Team divisions will have (4) four-member teams. Team members must check in together. Boys and girls will compete against each other. Doubles will be any combination of entrants. The oldest bowler will determine the division of the event.

8. Handicap: Handicap will be 90% of 220.

AT THE TOURNAMENT

- **9. Dress Code:** No headgear, cutoffs, tank tops, muscle shirts, clothing with offensive language and/or pictures, or bare midriffs will be allowed. Collared, mock, or sponsor shirts will be allowed. Shorts/skirts/skorts must be at a length where fingertips touch the hem. NO sport shorts. The tournament director shall have the final say in compliance with the dress code. *Failure to adhere to this rule will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and prizes*.
- 10. Check-In Times: Please check in 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time.
- **11. Lane Assignments:** All lane assignments are to be made by the tournament director. If it becomes necessary to reschedule bowlers in any event, it will be done at the discretion of the tournament director. In case of machine failure and it becomes impossible to complete an event within the allotted time, the event will be re-scheduled and bowling will resume at the point where it was discontinued.
- **12. Average Verification:** It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain, or someone else. Failure to use the proper average or make the correction prior to the end of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score bowled if the submitted average is lower than the proper average. If the submitted average is higher than the proper average, any final standings or monies will be based on the submitted average. USBC rules 319 is in effect.
- **13. Tardy Bowlers:** Tardy bowlers will start in the frame being bowled when they are ready for tournament play. They will receive *no score* for any frames missed. Teams refusing to start at the scheduled time shall forfeit their entry fee and will not be allowed to compete.
- 14. Substitutes: All substitutions must be made through the tournament office.
- **15. Bowling Balls**: Once practice is over and competition begins, surface alteration will not be allowed. During competition, a bowler may clean his ball using a **shammy or dry towel only**.
- **16. Score Sheets:** After a score sheet has been signed by a contestant or team captain, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Bowlers are cautioned to sign the score sheet only after ensuring its accuracy. Computer printouts from the participating center will be the official score sheet in all cases. These will be kept on file for 10 days.

AFTER THE TOURNAMENT

- **17. Protests:** Any protests pertaining to interpretation or application of tournament rules must be submitted in writing to the tournament director, with a copy to USBC and filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- **18. Scholarships:** Scholarship amounts will be determined by number of entries. Scholarships will be managed by SMART through USBC. Bowlers will have eight (8) years from high school graduation to use the scholarship. Expired scholarships will revert to the Pikes Peak Youth Scholarship fund.
- **19: Additional Rules:** A) All food and beverages must be kept out of the settee area. B) Only bowlers, tournament officials, or center staff will be allowed in bowler area. NO PARENTS OR COACHES allowed in the settee area.

USBC rules and regulations will apply in all instances not specifically covered in the above rules as stated. The PPUSBC tournament director will make rulings on all questions, disputes, and rules not covered by these tournament rules.
