JUNIOR SCRATCH ELIMINATOR RULES 2019-2020

PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT

- **1. Eligibility:** This tournament is open to individuals who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to August 1, 2019 and have maintained compliance with USBC Youth Rule 400. Bowlers will be required to show their USBC membership card for the current 2019-2020 season.
- **2. Entry Fees:** The entry fee per bowler is \$50, broken down as follows: linage \$18.00, expenses \$3.00, and prize fund, paid in the form of scholarships, \$29.00.
- **3. No Refunds:** No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund once the tournament begins. Prior to the start of the tournament, a refund may be given if the bowler notifies the association manager that they will be unable to bowl.
- 4. Prize Ratio: 1 in 3.

AT THE TOURNAMENT

- **5. Dress Code:** Shirts with names on the back are encouraged but not required. Absolutely no t-shirts, blue jeans, shorts, sweats, warmup gear, leggings, yoga pants, pajamas, bare midriffs or clothing with offensive pictures/language. No headgear allowed. Appropriate attire includes collared shirts, mock bowling shirts, and dress slacks. Skirts or skorts may be worn only if the fingertips touch the bottom of said apparel. Dress code will be strictly enforced. *Non-compliance will result in removal from tournament area and forfeiture of any entry fees paid.*
- 6. Check-In Times: Please check in 30 minutes before tournament begins.
- **7. Lane Assignments:** All lane assignments are to be made by the tournament director. If it becomes necessary to reschedule bowlers in any event, it will be done at the discretion of the tournament director. In case of machine failure and it becomes impossible to complete an event within the allotted time, the event will be re-scheduled and bowling will resume at the point where it was discontinued.
- **8. Tardy Bowlers:** Tardy bowlers will start in the frame being bowled when they are ready for tournament play. They will receive *no score* for any frames missed. Anyone refusing to start at the scheduled time shall forfeit their entry fee and will not be allowed to compete.
- **9. Bowling Balls**: Once practice is over and competition begins, surface alteration will not be allowed. During competition, a bowler may clean their ball using a **shammy or dry towel only**.
- **10. Score Sheets:** After a score sheet has been signed by a contestant, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Bowlers are cautioned to sign the score sheet only after ensuring its accuracy. Computer printouts from the participating center will be the official score sheet in all cases. These will be kept on file for 10 days.
- **11. Tournament format: Qualifying round:** There will be 6 games of qualifying. In case of a tie for the last spot after qualifying, there will be one ball roll off. 1/3 of the field in each division will move to the eliminator round. Pins do not carry over to next round.

Eliminator rounds: Round 1: Players in the first eliminator round will bowl 2 games. Each game will be bowled on a different pair. The field will change pairs after game 1 and bowl game 2 on the other pair. The field will be cut to 1/3 based on the 2-game total pins from round 1 of the eliminator. Pins do not carry over to next round.

Round 2: Players still in the eliminator will bowl 2 games in round 2. Each game will be bowled on a different pair. The field will change pairs after game 1 and bowl game 2 on the other pair. The field will be cut to 1/3 based on the 2-game total pins from round 2 of the eliminator. Pins do not carry over to next round.

Round 3: The finalists will move to another pair and bowl one game with the low score being eliminated after each game. This format will continue (including lane changes) until a winner is determined.

12. Additional Rules: A) All food and beverages must be kept out of the settee area. B) Only bowlers, tournament officials, or center staff will be allowed in bowler area. No parents or coaches allowed in the settee area. C) No alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the bowling or spectator areas of the bowling center while the tournament is being conducted. D) Unsportsmanlike behavior by a player at any time is grounds for disqualification. No exceptions. Spectators may also be removed from the bowling center at the discretion of the tournament director in the case of unruly or unsportsmanlike behavior. E) No electronic devices will be allowed in the settee area during play, such as cell phones, PDAs, computers, personal music players, and/or gaming devices. F) Once a bowler begins the tournament with a right or left handed delivery, they must finish the tournament with the same delivery.

AFTER THE TOURNAMENT

- **13. Protests:** Any protests pertaining to interpretation or application of tournament rules must be submitted in writing to the tournament director, with a copy to USBC and filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- **14. Scholarships:** Scholarship amounts will be determined by number of entries. Scholarships will be managed by SMART through USBC. Bowlers will have eight (8) years from high school graduation to use the scholarship. Expired scholarships will revert to the Pikes Peak Youth Scholarship fund.

USBC rules and regulations will apply in all instances not specifically covered in the above rules as stated. The PPUSBC tournament director will make rulings on all questions, disputes, and rules not covered by these tournament rules.
