2018/2019 Senior Ladies Handicap Tournament

- 1. **ELIGIBILITY**: Tournament is open to all women PPUSBC members who are at least 50 years of age as of the date of bowling the first event. All participants must show current USBC Membership Card at check-in. Non-USBC bowlers who reside within the Pikes Peak USBC area (El Paso and Teller Counties) may qualify by paying the \$25 USBC membership fee. Any USBC member who identifies herself as a "Professional" may participate. There is a limit of only one professional bowler on any four-person team or Doubles team. All-Events winner will be based on a 9-game total, plus handicap. The All-Events fees must be paid to participate in the prize fund for All-Events.
- 2. <u>MULTIPLE ENTRIES</u>: Bowlers may enter multiple Team events. No more than two bowlers may participate together on multiple teams. Multiple entries are allowed in doubles, with a different partner. Multiple entries are allowed in singles. Bowlers entering Doubles or Singles as a multiple entry can bowl one or the other or both. First score in each event will count towards All-Events. Individual bowlers may place only once in the top ten in Singles.
- 3. <u>DRESS CODE</u>: NO headgear, cutoffs, tank tops, muscle shirts, clothing with offensive language/pictures, or bare midriffs will be allowed. Shorts/Skorts/Skirts must be at a length where fingertips touch hem. Failure to adhere to these rules will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees and prizes. Tournament manager shall have final say in compliance with dress code.
- 4. <u>AVERAGES</u>: Highest 2017-2018 average of 21 games or more will be used. If a bowler does not have a 2017-2018 average, they may use their highest current certified league average of 21 games or more as of Feb. 28, 2019. If a bowler does not have any of the qualifying averages, they will be assigned a scratch average of 220. Bowlers who are required to use a current league average must show verification signed by their league secretary or produce a League Standing Sheet showing their current average as of Feb. 28, 2019.
- 5. **AVERAGE VERIFICATION**: It is a bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler, Team Captain or someone else. Failure to use the proper average or make the correction prior to the end of the first game of a series, shall disqualify the score bowled if the submitted average is lower than the proper average. Rules 319a, 319a2, 319d and 319e are in effect. Rule 329 is also in effect. USBC RULES APPLY IN ALL INSTANCES.
- 6. HANDICAP: shall be based on 90% of 220.
- 7. ENTRY FEES: Per bowler, per event; Prize Fund \$13.25, Linage \$6.75, Expenses \$5, for a total of \$25.00.
- 8. **PRIZE RATIO**: shall be on a 1 in 5 basis. Awards shall be given to the winners of each event, ie Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events.
- 9. **NO REFUNDS**: No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund after definite dates and times have been assigned. Confirmation letters will be emailed to the person whom submitted the entry form. Contact the Tournament Office at 719-963-9656, if you have any questions.
- 10. **LANE ASSIGNMENTS**: are drawn randomly. In case of a machine failure and it becomes impossible to complete an event within the allotted time, the event will be rescheduled and bowling will resume at the point where it was discontinued.
- 11. **TEAM CAPTAIN**: is responsible for the submission of each entry and all fees. She is the team representative and will serve in all matters pertaining to individual behavior and complaints with Tournament and USBC Rules.
- 12. CHECK-IN TIMES: All bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled squad starting time.
- 13. <u>TARDY BOWLERS</u>: Will start in the frame being bowled when they are READY for tournament play and will receive a zero for each frame missed. Teams refusing to start at the scheduled time shall forfeit their entry fee and will not be allowed to compete.
- 14. **SCORE SHEETS**: After a score sheet has been signed by a contestant or Team Captain, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Bowlers are cautioned to sign score sheet only after ensuring its accuracy. Computer printouts from the participating center will be the official score sheets in all cases. These will be kept on file for 10 days.
- 15. **PROTESTS**: Any protest pertaining to interpretation or application of tournament rules must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager, with a copy to USBC and filed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

Pikes Peak USBC may use all photographs (with or without names), for, but not limited to, the following purposes: publicity, illustration, advertising, web content and social media.

USBC rules and regulations will apply in all instances not specifically covered in the above rules as stated. The PPUSBC Tournament Manager will make rulings on all questions, disputes and rules not covered by these tournament rules.
